Instantly Leon knew he had no choice. He left everything behind, went to India, and searched for God. He decided to put all his preconceived notions about religion aside and fearlessly looked for answers.





He danced to exhaustion with colorfully dressed practitioners in a marble temple of the Hari Krishna






At a riverside ashram while hundreds of worshippers prayed in unison to the setting sun, Leon sat alone with an Indian holy man who blessed his journey with an immersive message
